**BYLAW No. (7) Issued Pursuant to
Articles (67) and (70) of Civil Aviation Law No. 41 of 2007.**

The TTBS (Ticket Tax Bos Services) has been advised by Royal Jordanian (RJ) that a ticket charge code is required for the airport security charge collection.

An additional tax collection per flight segment and APIS update will be compulsory for the traveller on international flights who has a confirmed ticket, including the traveller:

- a) Arriving to or departing from the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan,
- b) Transfer Passenger or the Transit Passenger.

Tax details are as below for your kind understanding and distribution to all staff concerned.

1/ Country Name: **Jordan**

ISO Code: **JO**

2/ Name of Tax/Charge/Fee: **Airport Security Charge**

3/ Ticket Code: **O7**

4/ Effective date: **Effective for tickets issued on/after 16 February 2020, for travel on/after 16 February 2020.**

5/ Purpose: **The Security Charge is imposed on passenger air transport for Advanced Passenger Information.**

6/ Amounts:

JOD 1.75 Applied on the International arrivals and departures (per flight segment).

Example: AMM-DXB-AMM total amount JOD 3.50

JOD 1.25 Applied on transit/transfer passengers via Jordan (per flight segment).

Example: LHR-X/AMM-DXB-X/AMM-LHR total amount JOD 5

7/ The tax is to be collected at **point of sale** and shown separately on the ticket by code **O7**

8/ The **lifting airline** will be responsible for remittance.

9/ This Tax is: **Interlineable.**

10/ Refundability – non refundable

11/ **Exemptions –**

- IN1 - Infants under 2 years without seat
- CR - Airline crew on duty
